We are committed to reducing our greenhouse gas emissions and to protecting and supporting biodiversity. As part of that commitment, this year we set ourselves a target of reducing our greenhouse gas emissions from energy, water and waste by 20% before the end of 2030, with an annual target of 5% reduction.


We know that there is more work to for us to do and in 2026 we are implementing a number of new initiatives throughout our operation to help us achieve our 2030 goal. We encourage our valued guests, staff and visitors to support us by following the reminders we have provided throughout the hotel about saving water and energy, as well as minimising waste.

The hotel is also actively phasing out refrigerants containing R422 gases before the end of 2030 due to their high global warming potential, replacing them with more environmentally responsible alternatives where feasible.

We encourage our guests, staff, suppliers and partners to support our sustainability goals through responsible practices and collaboration.
